

Hello! If you're reading this, that means that you've expressed interest in having your child take private percussion lessons! Private lessons are extremely beneficial for your child's success and confidence in music, and I'm so happy that you are investing in your child's growth through music and life! Here's some information that will allow for the lessons to run smoothly:

Lesson Contract

Location

Private lessons will take place at **Science Hill High School**. The two percussion rooms are right next to each other, so if I'm not in one, I'm probably in the other one! Because of how active the Science Hill band is, there may be occasions when I will need to relocate to a different room. I will promptly send out an email as soon as I can about where lessons will be if this happens.

Time

Once I collect everyone's availability, I will make a lesson schedule and send it out to you. We will meet weekly at your scheduled time, unless otherwise communicated.

Materials

I will often assign music for your child to work on independently. Please make sure that they bring that music for each lesson, as I will constantly be making notes/goals on the music to help them practice more efficiently.

Payment Information

30 minute lesson: \$30 per lesson	1 hour lesson: \$60 per lesson

Lesson payment is due monthly, at the first lesson of each month. For example, if there are 4 Tuesdays in a month, the payment would be \$120 (for 30 min. lessons), due on the first Tuesday of the month.

If payment is not received by the second lesson of the month, I will not teach that lesson, nor any more lessons until payment has been received (I have unfortunately been in this situation before, and would like to avoid going through that again! Thank you for understanding!).

Method of Payment

Absences

Life happens, and there will be times when your child can't be at a lesson. That's okay, as long as you give me **at least 24-hours notice**. It's a bummer for me to find out moments before a lesson that your child couldn't make it. If I have enough notice, I can shift my lesson schedule for the day. If not, I have an empty time slot and no student to teach. I can roll the payment over to the next month if clear advance communication has been made. If not, **I reserve the right to charge you for the lesson, even if your child did not make it to the lesson.**

If I need to miss a lesson, I will do my best to let you know before the beginning of the month. If something comes up unexpectedly, I will either work to reschedule the lesson in a timely manner, or roll that lesson's payment over to the next month.

I'm so excited to meet the students, and I truly hope your child will enjoy lessons! Please let me know if you have questions, and I'm looking forward to getting started!
